

Oak Hill Cemetery

Oak Hill Cemetery, consecrated in 1842 and still an active burial ground, was part of the early garden cemetery movement in the United States. The beautiful landscape is the final resting place of writers, artists, silversmiths, abolitionists, photographers, and sea captains.



Ellen T. Brown Memorial Chapel

The Ellen T. Brown Memorial Chapel was built in 1914 for the purpose of funerals. It closed in 1953 and subsequently fell into disrepair. Exterior restoration was initiated and completed in 2007. The ongoing second phase is focused on the interior. The chapel restoration is supported in part by: the **Newburyport Five Cents Savings** Bank Foundation, the Essex National Heritage Commission, the Newburyport Civic League, the Mayor Gayden W. Morrill Charitable Foundation, and private donors Beth Gerwig and Gail and Joe Santarlasci.

The Newburyport Preservation Trust recognized the trustees for chapel restoration (2008).
